Tour A:

Sir Bani Yas Island - Luxury and Nature combined

Dates: 13 to 15 April. 3 Days, 2 Nights, including travel time of half a day each way. (An airport hotel is available if needed, at an additional cost. Please refer to the registration form for details)

Located 170 kilometers southwest of Abu Dhabi, Sir Bani Yas is the largest natural island in the UAE and was first settled thousands of years ago. Many archaeological sites have been discovered, one of the oldest being the remains of a Christian monastery which dates back over 1,400 years. What makes Sir Bani Yas so special for visitors is the Arabian Wildlife Park, one of the region's largest, established in 1977 by the late Sheikh Zayed Bin Sultan Al Nahyan to preserve some of the region's endangered species.

Thanks to decades of ecological and conservation work, the park is now home to thousands of free-roaming animals, including Arabian oryx, gazelles, giraffes, hyenas and cheetahs, as well as over 100 species of birds. During your stay at the luxurious 5-star Anantara Desert Resorts & Spa, a variety of activities are available to suit your preferences. The highlights include nature walks and wildlife drives led by expert guides. The resort's well-managed stables also offer a range of riding experiences tailored to different skill levels. We kindly ask that you select your preferred activities in advance on the Conference Registration form, especially for Day 1. Activities chosen from the options provided below will be paid directly to the hotel by each guest after the activity is completed. This allows for flexibility in case of adverse weather conditions or plan changes. (See below for prices).

We encourage you to book early to secure your spot, as space on this tour may be limited. Each guest is allowed a maximum of one piece of luggage weighing up to 30kg and one piece of hand luggage weighing up to 7kg. Kindly note that bringing alcohol to the island is not permitted.

Proposed Tour Schedule:

DAY 1 | SUNDAY 13 APRIL

After breakfast at your Abu Dhabi hotel and check-out

08:00: Departure by our tour bus from your Abu Dhabi hotel (Approximately 3 hours drive)

12:30: Arrive at Jebel Al Dhanna Jetty for transfer by speedboat to Sir Bani Yas Island

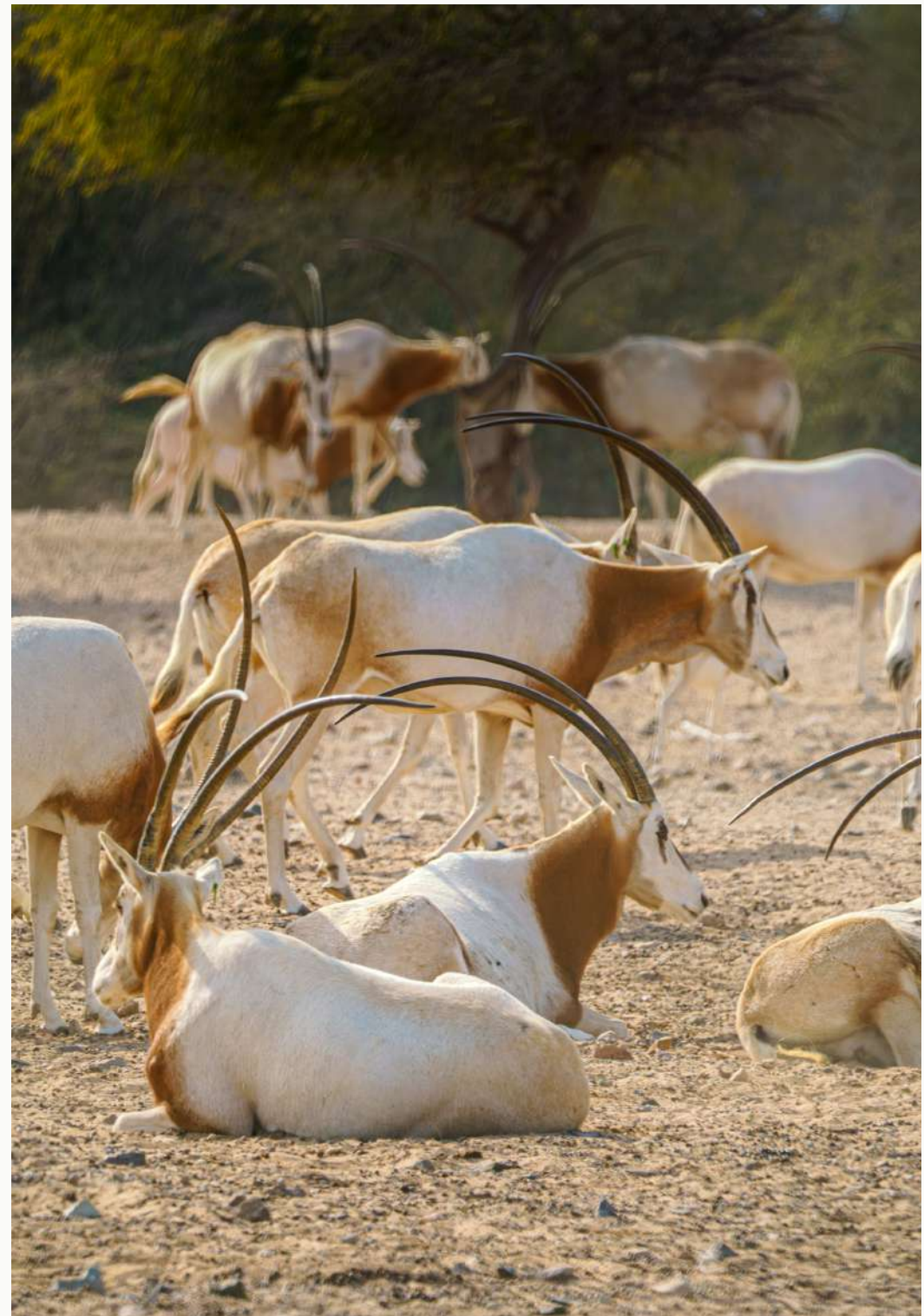
13:00: Arrive on the island and transfer to Anantara Desert Resorts & Spa in time for lunch

15:00: Check-in

15:30: Nature and Wildlife Drive. We will all set out for a guided 4x4 adventure around the Arabian Wildlife Park. This tour provides excellent photo opportunities of the animals and insights into the conservation efforts on the island.

17.30: Culture and History Tour. Discover different archaeological sites, such as the monastery from 600 CE, learn about local history, and discover the ancient tradition of falconry. Please wear comfortable clothing and closed/sports shoes

20:00: Dinner at the hotel



DAY 2 | MONDAY 14 APRIL

06:15: Wildlife Horse Ride. Before breakfast: Transfer to the Sir Bani Yas Stables for an exclusive ride starting at 6:30 a.m. This activity is reserved for experienced riders who can confidently control a fit horse. The ride lasts approximately two hours and offers a unique opportunity to get up close to the animals in the southern part of the wildlife park. Participants are advised to wear long trousers and socks; helmets, boots, and chaps will be provided. Please note the weight limit is 85kg. After the ride, you will return to the hotel to enjoy breakfast and rest.

Or: 8:00: Bush or Beach Ride. After breakfast: Transfer to Sir Bani Yas Stables for your choice of a Bush or Beach ride, lasting between 1 to 2 hours. The ride begins at 8:30 a.m. and is ideal for intermediate riders. This guided experience takes you through bush landscapes along sandy tracks and includes the unique opportunity to let your horse splash in the sea. Riders are advised to wear long trousers and socks; helmets, boots, and chaps will be provided. Please note the weight limit is 85kg.

Or: 08:30: Guided Nature Walk. After breakfast: If you prefer not to ride, you can opt for a guided walk through a safe area of the Arabian Wildlife Park to observe wild animals. The walk lasts approximately 1.5 hours. Please wear comfortable clothing, closed or sports shoes, a hat, and sunscreen for your comfort and protection.

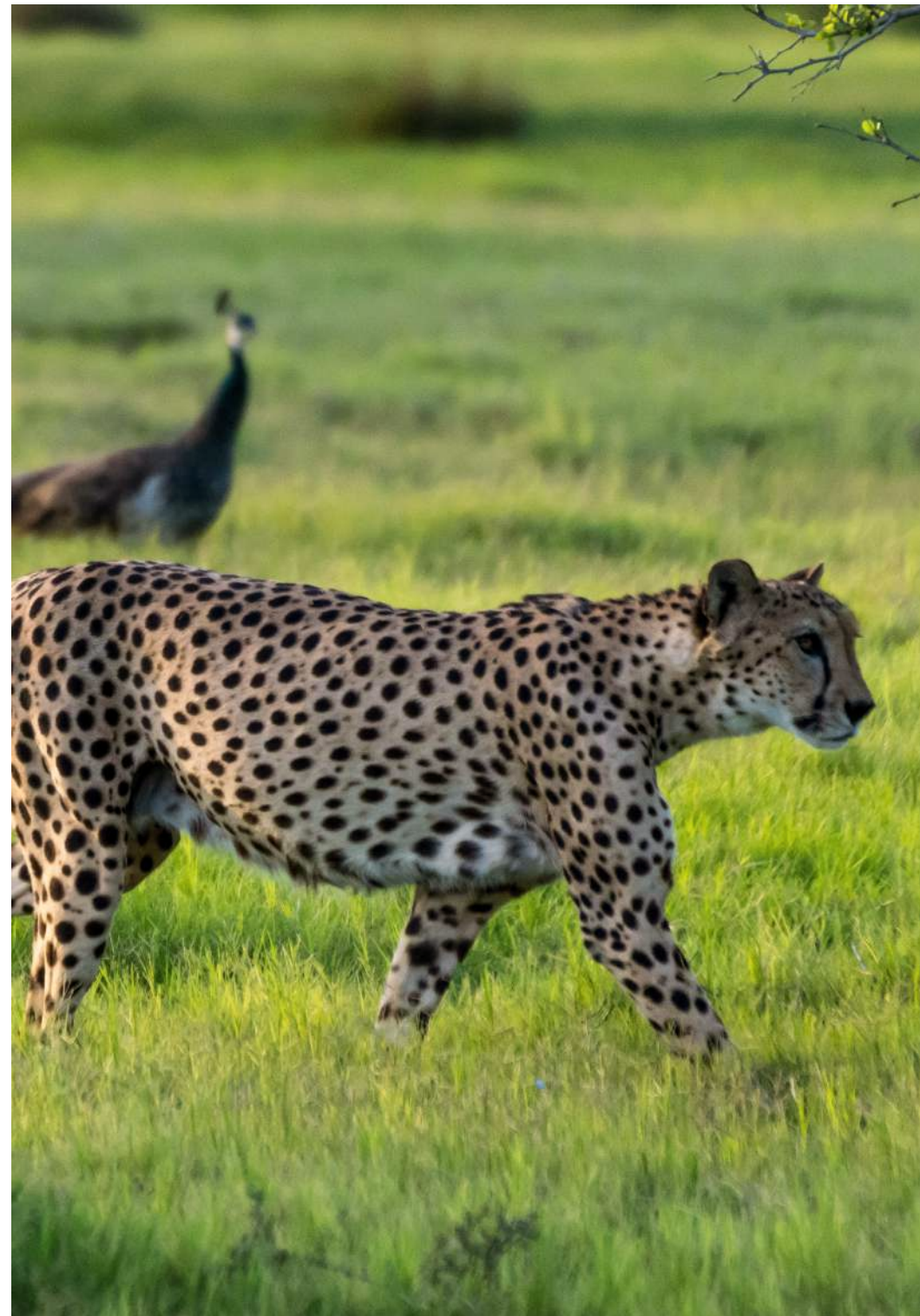
11:00: Return to hotel to freshen up. Free time to relax and enjoy the hotel amenities.

Dubai is renowned for its iconic skyline, featuring the world's tallest building, the monumental Burj Khalifa, and luxurious shopping malls, beautiful beaches, and bustling ports. Originally established in the 19th century as a fishing village, it has evolved into a global hub for regional and international trade and a highly sought-after destination for tourists.

Sharjah, one of the UAE's largest Emirates, spans two coastlines: the Persian Gulf to the west and the Gulf of Oman to the east. Celebrated for its rich history and stunning Arabic and Islamic architecture, Sharjah has earned the title of *"Cultural Capital of the Arab World"* from UNESCO, recognising its dedication to preserving and promoting Arab culture and heritage.

Ras Al Khaimah, the northernmost Emirate of the UAE, is set against a backdrop of sea, mountains, and desert. With over 7,000 years of continuous human habitation, it was once a centre of the pearling industry. Today, its breathtaking natural landscapes include vast sandy beaches and the rugged Hajar Mountains, home to Jebel Jais, the UAE's highest peak.

Fujairah, located on the country's eastern side along the Gulf of Oman, is a haven of serene natural beauty. Its unspoiled beaches, vibrant coral reefs, and historic forts make it a unique and tranquil destination.

Proposed Tour Schedule:

DAY 1 | SUNDAY 13 APRIL

08:00: Check out and depart for Dubai. (Approx. 1.5-hour drive).

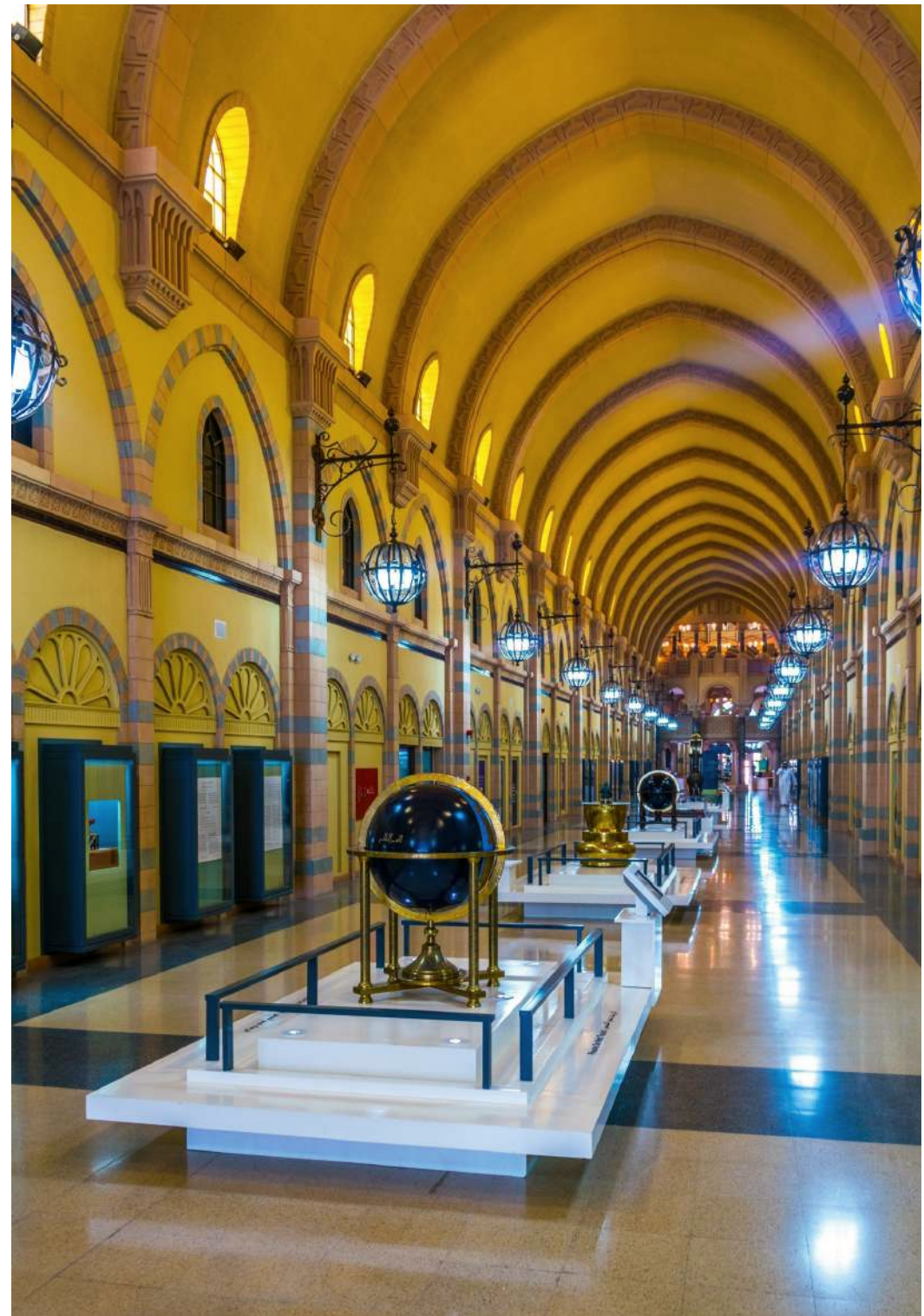

(Approx. 1.5-hour drive)

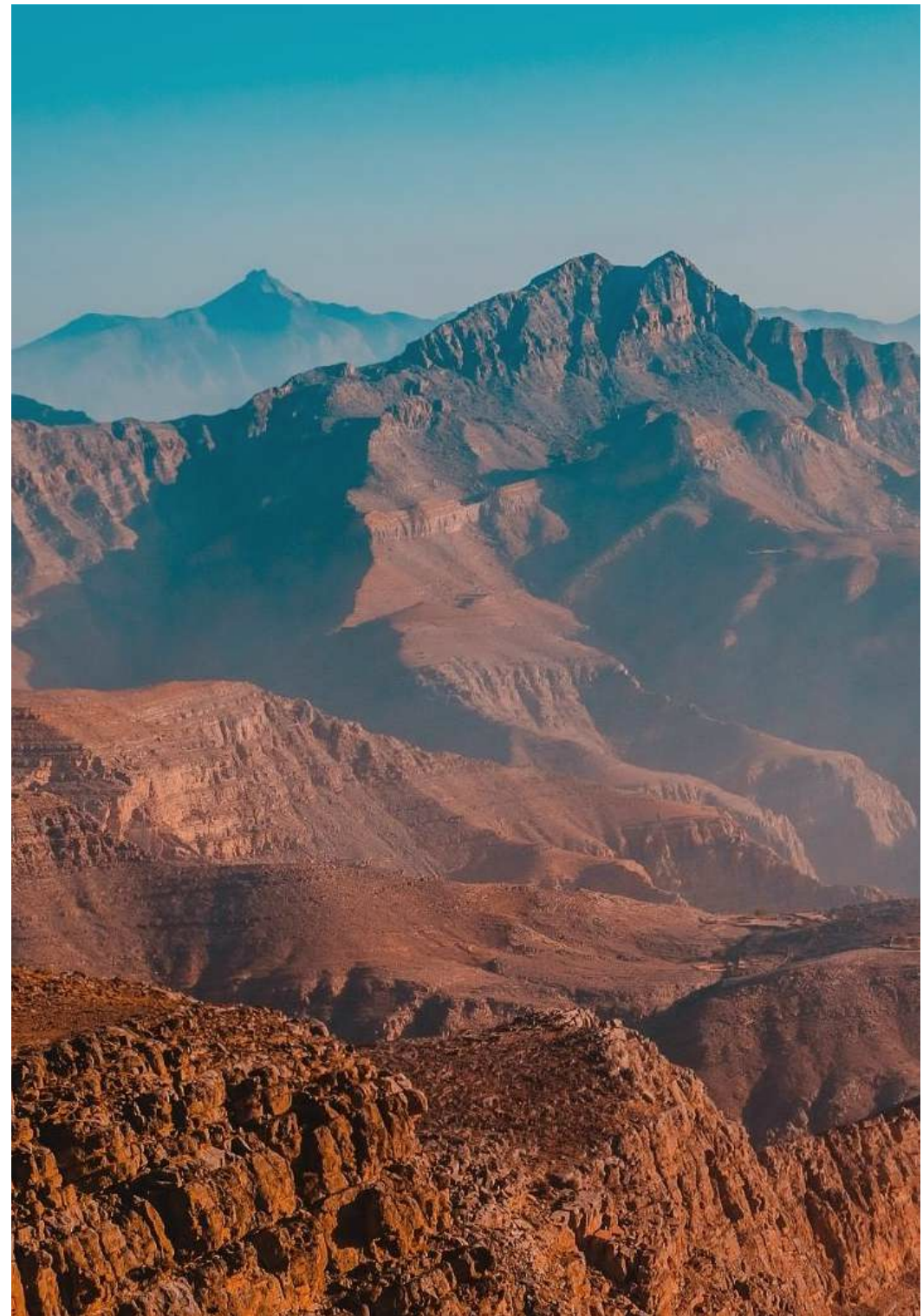
10:00: Suwaidi Pearl Farm Hidden Gem Guided Tour.

Located in the small fishing village of Al Rams, Suwaidi Pearl Farm is the world's first Arabian pearl farm. Our 2.5-hour tour includes a journey on a traditional pearling boat, offering a unique opportunity to explore the historical, scientific, and cultural significance of the region's pearl-diving heritage. Guests are kindly requested to adhere to a modest dress code and wear flat shoes.

15:30: Transfer to Ras Al Khaimah Hotel and Check in.

16:00 - 18:30: Afternoon activity to be arranged.

19:30: Dinner at the Hotel.



DAY 3 | TUESDAY 15 APRIL

09:00: Check out and depart for the Mleiha Archaeological Centre (approx. 1.5 hour drive)

10:30: Guided Archaeological Tour: Uncover the secrets of the region's ancient inhabitants and cultures. We will begin at the Exhibition Centre, before moving outside to explore the many ancient sites that have been discovered here, deep in the deserts of Sharjah. Option to tour part of the site in a 4x4 or by camel if you prefer not to walk too far.

13:00: Lunch in Mleiha Bistro Café

14:00: Drive to Fujairah (approx. 1 hour)

15:00: Check in at Hotel.

15.30: Fujairah Sightseeing: Afternoon tour of old Fujairah including the Fujairah Fort, Al Bidya Mosque & Heritage Village.

20:00: Dinner at hotel.



DAY 4 | WEDNESDAY 16 APRIL

08.30: Free time after breakfast for relaxing on the beach, swimming and, for confident swimmers, the option of snorkeling at Snoopy Island

11.00: Return to hotel to freshen up and check out by 12 noon.

12:30: After lunch in a local restaurant, step back in time as we browse around Fujairah Old Souq, through narrow lanes lined with shops selling traditional handicrafts, pottery, and handmade jewelry. Al Ain, the UAE's second-largest city, is at the foot of the Hajar Mountains along the UAE-Oman border. Known as the Garden City for its abundant greenery, it is the birthplace of HH Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan, the UAE's founding father, and home to some of the Middle East's earliest Bedouin settlements. Al Ain boasts verdant palm groves, natural springs, and the expansive Al Ain Oasis, which holds great historical and cultural significance. Recognised as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, the oasis is one of the oldest continuously inhabited settlements in the UAE.

This tour concludes at the Arabian Nights Village, a destination that offers a truly unique desert experience. Nestled among towering desert dunes in a lush, palm-fringed oasis, it is located between Al Ain and Abu Dhabi, providing an unforgettable glimpse into the region's rich heritage and natural beauty.



DAY 1 | SUNDAY 13 APRIL

08:30: Departure from your hotel to Al Ain (approx. 1.5 hours)

10:00: Guided Tour of Al Ain We begin our tour at the iconic Qasr Al Ain (Sheikh Zayed Palace Museum), which provides a fascinating glimpse into the life of the UAE's founding father. The journey continues to the Al Ain Museum, where you can delve into the rich history and heritage of the UAE. Next, we visit the Al Jahili Fort, renowned for its traditional Emirati architecture and its permanent exhibition dedicated to the explorer and photographer Wilfred Thesiger.

Guided Tour of Al Ain Oasis. After a lunch break at a local restaurant, we will continue with a guided tour of the picturesque Al Ain Oasis. The tour begins with a visit to the information center, followed by an exploration of the ancient Falaj irrigation system. Stroll along the shady pathways beneath the lush canopy of palm and mango trees, immersing yourself in the oasis's serene beauty and rich heritage.

18.30: Transfer to the hotel for check-in

19:30: Dinner at the hotel.



DAY 2 | MONDAY 14 APRIL

9:30: Jebel Hafeet Desert Park. We will begin our morning exploring the famous Beehive Tombs, remarkable 5,000-year-old structures that mark the start of the Bronze Age in the UAE. Following this, we will ascend the winding mountain road leading to the summit of the majestic Jebel Hafeet. At the top, we will pause for a coffee break at the Al Berini Hotel before heading to the viewing deck, where you can take in the breathtaking views of the rugged and dramatic landscape.

13:00: Lunch at Le Belvedere Restaurant in the Mercure Hotel at the top of Jebel Hafeet

14:30: Green Mubazzarah Hot Springs. After descending from Jebel Hafeet, we will stop here, where the natural thermal waters are surrounded by beautiful scenery.

17:00: Qaryat Al Torath Heritage Village. We conclude our tour with time to explore the vibrant market stalls, offering a wide array of traditional Emirati handicrafts. You'll also have the opportunity to enjoy traditional Emirati coffee, tea, and snacks, providing a delightful end to the experience.

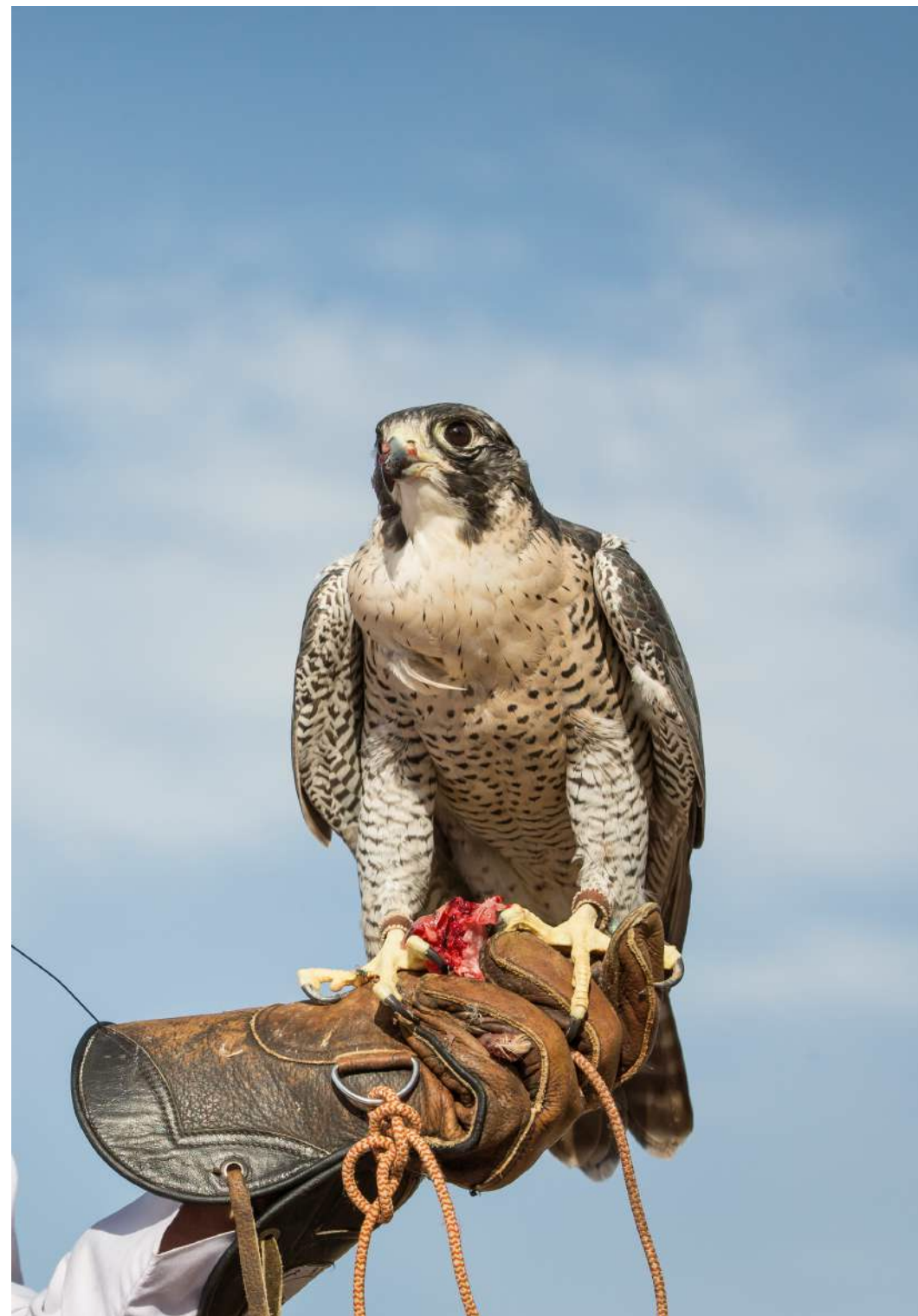
TOUR 3A ALL ABOUT THE ANIMALS TOUR (5 & 6 APRIL MORNING START)

Additionally, Abu Dhabi offers tranquil natural escapes, showcasing the importance of ecosystems in protecting the coastline and supporting biodiversity.

We start our day with a guided tour of the brand new state-of-the-art Abu Dhabi Equine and Camel Hospital, the world's first dual species facility dedicated to the care and treatment of horses and camels. We then move on to the Abu Dhabi Falcon Hospital, the world's largest hospital for falcons, where you'll learn about the care and conservation of these majestic and iconic birds. We will end our tour with lunch at a local restaurant.

After lunch at a local restaurant, when Tour 3A ends, Tour 3B will continue to Jubail Mangrove Park for a walking tour along the boardwalk, led by a park ranger. You can choose from three loops around the flat boardwalk (1km, 1.6km or 2km) and immerse yourself in the serene beauty of this unique habitat. There may also be the option of taking the 20-minute exploration of Jubail Mangrove Park's pristine mangrove forest in an eco-friendly electric vehicle.

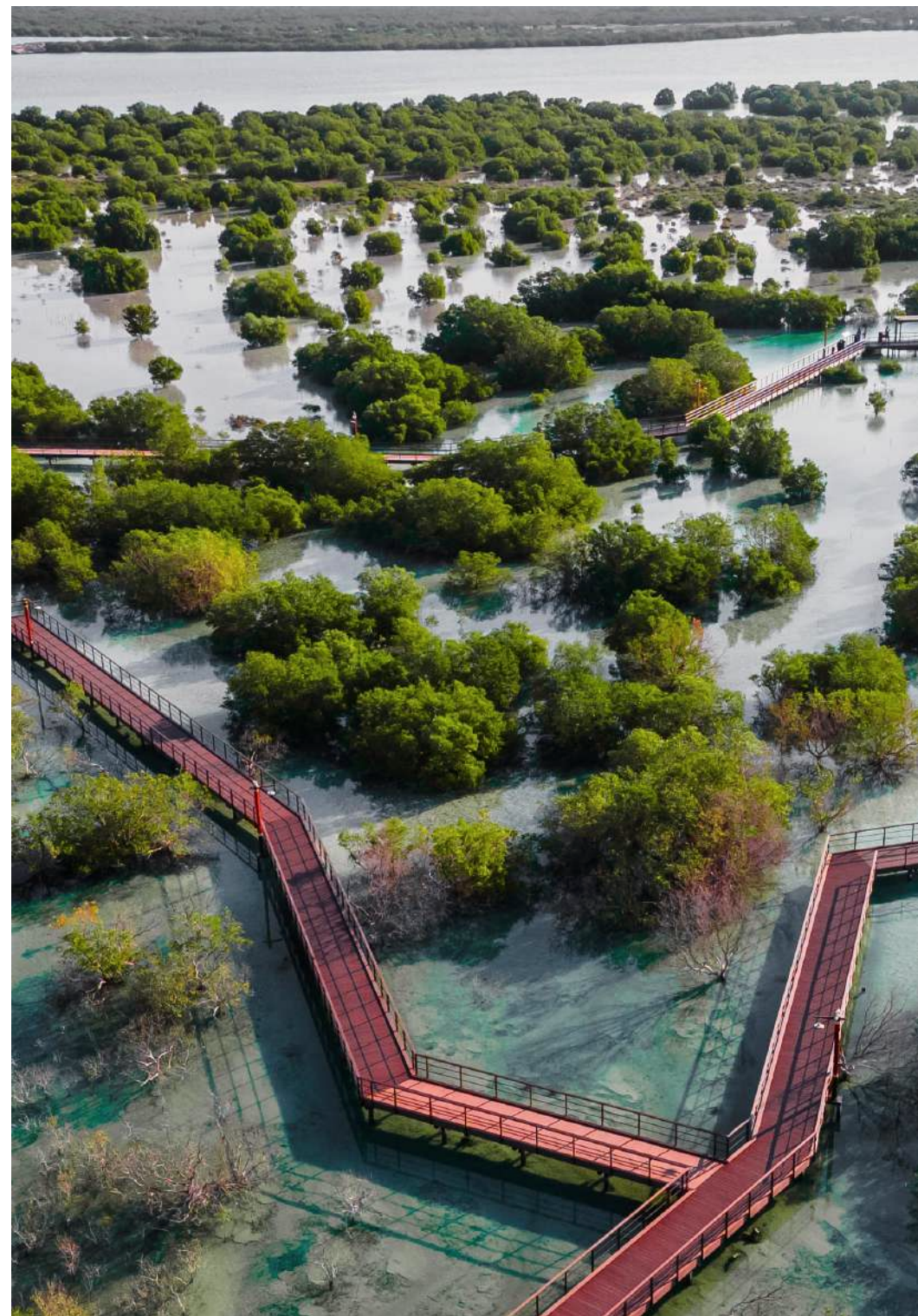

19:00: Depart for return to your hotel (Approximately 2 hours drive).



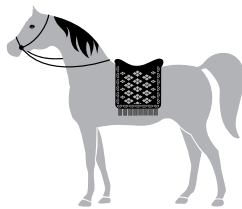
